## Buddhist Canon

In order to establish Buddhism firmly in China, scriptures were translated from Sanskrit into Chinese. Countless people were involved in this task. National Master Kumarajiva (5th century) headed a team of over 800 in a decade-long translation project of the Tripitaka (Buddhist Canon). Because of this work, nearly the entire Buddhist Canon of over a thousand texts exists today in Chinese.

Now as Buddhism is being planted in Western soil, the same translation work is being done from Chinese into English. The **Buddhist Text Translation Society (BTT)** founded by Tripitaka Master Hsuan Hua in 1970, is working toward this goal with committees headed by Bhikshus (monks) and Bhikshunis (nuns) devoted to translation, revision, editing and certification of the entire Tripitaka.



## Tripitaka Master Hsuan Hua (1918 – 1995)



At first glance, he looked and sounded like any other Chinese immigrant in San Francisco in the 1960s. His humble manner belied his position as the 45<sup>th</sup> Buddhist patriarch in direct lineage from Shakyamuni Buddha.

Master Hua was born in 1918 near Manchuria, China into a family of frugal farmers. He learned to read at 15, and after his mother's death at 19, he became a monk. He meditated by his mother's grave for three years and practiced other austerities before receiving full ordination.

At Nan Hua Monastery in Canton, Master Hua received the mind-to-mind transmission of the Patriarchs Master Hsu Yun, making him a Patriarch in direct lineage with Bodhidharma, the last patriarch of India, and Hui Neng, the first patriarch of Zen.

With the arrival of the communists on the Chinese mainland, the Master went to Hong Kong to promote orthodox Buddhism. In 1962, he brought monastic, Mahayana Buddhism to America. He founded the City of Ten Thousand Buddhas, the International Translation Institute, and over 20 other monasteries and temples all over the globe, with the goal of spreading Buddhism worldwide.

## Dharma Realm Buddhist Association (DRBA)

The Buddhist Text Translation Society is part of DRBA. Formerly known as the Sino-American Buddhist Association, it was founded by Venerable Master Hsuan Hua in 1959. It was established as a state and federally approved non-profit religious and educational corporation for the purpose of bringing the orthodox teachings of the Buddha to the entire world.

In 1962, Master Hua accepted his disciples' invitation to come to America. In 1966 he set up an in-residence Buddhist study and practice center in San Francisco. In 1970 the center moved to larger quarters and became one of Northern California's foremost Buddhist centers: Gold Mountain Monastery.

Later the Association founded a number of other centers: The International Institute for the Translation of Buddhist Texts (1973), The Sagely City of Ten Thousand Buddhas in Ukiah (1976) and numerous branch monasteries including the Berkeley Buddhist Monastery which houses the Institute of World Religions. The City of Ten Thousand Buddhas also houses The Dharma Realm Buddhist University ([www.drba.org](http://www.drba.org)), Developing Virtue Secondary School, Instilling Goodness Elementary School, Jyun Kang Vegetarian Restaurant and an organic farm.

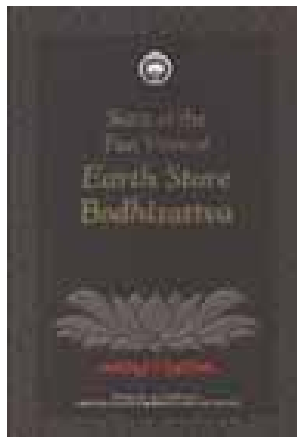


## The Sutra in Forty-Two Sections

This short yet important sutra gives us a picture of the entire range of the Buddha's teachings, from the basic to the profound. With its repeated emphasis on the importance of eliminating desire and greed, this sutra is excellent medicine for our society, which is plagued by materialism and over consumption. This was the first sutra transmitted from India to China and was brought by two extraordinary Indian monks on a white horse around 67 C.E. This prompted the emperor of China to establish the White Horse Monastery at Loyang. Tripitaka Master Hua's commentary gives clear and straight forward explanations illustrating the principles of orthodox Buddhism.

## Sutra of the Past Vows of Earth Store Bodhisattva

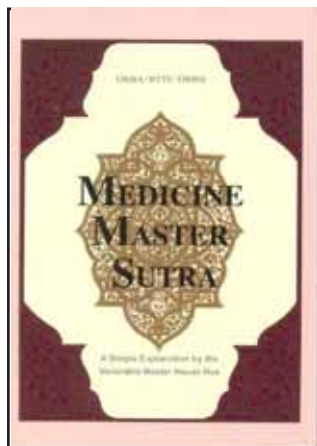
Reminiscent of Dante's *Inferno* but largely unknown in the West, this sutra, which discusses the workings of karma and rebirth, describes the various Buddhist hells and the reasons for falling into them. Spoken by Shakyamuni Buddha, it tells us that he entrusted Earth Store (Ksitigarbha) Bodhisattva with the endless task of rescuing all living beings from suffering.

Earth Store's long history and extraordinary vows to accomplish this impossible task have made this an extremely popular Buddhist text and the predominant funeral scripture in East Asia for centuries. Master Hua and his disciples published the first ever English translation from classical Chinese.

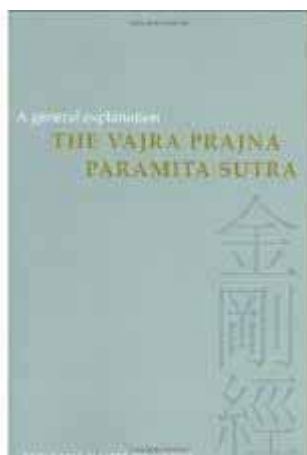

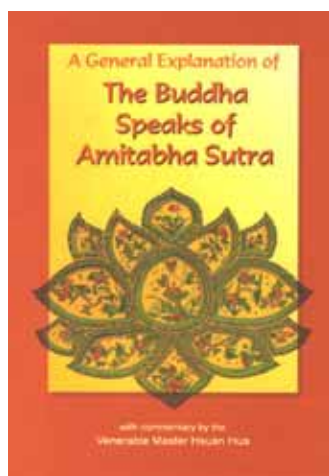

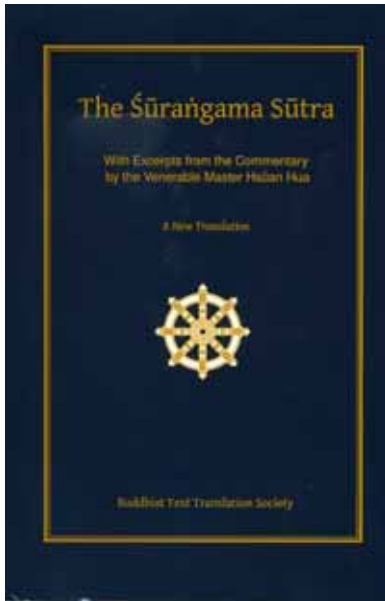

## The Surangama Sutra

### A New Translation

For over a thousand years, the *Surangama Sutra* has been held in great esteem in the Mahayana Buddhist countries of East and Southeast Asia and has been as popular as the *Lotus*, *Heart* and *Diamond Sutras*. Its wealth of theoretical and practical instruction in the spiritual life often made it the first major text to be studied by newly ordained monks, particularly in the Chan School.

The Sutra has been regarded as a complete and practical manual for spiritual practice that will lead to enlightenment. It gives instruction in the correct understanding of the Buddha-nature, which is the potential within all beings for becoming a Buddha. The Sutra explains how and why this true nature is hidden and how we can uncover this nature and recognize that it is our own true mind. The Sutra also explains that personal integrity and purity of conduct are prerequisites for spiritual awakening. It presents the principles of meditation, and provides guidelines for discerning what practices are correct and which deviate into wrong ones. It explains how our own intentional acts, whether physical, verbal, or mental, result in our experiences, including rebirths at various levels of being, both human and non-human.

At the heart of the Sutra is the Surangama Mantra. The Sutra promises that the practice of reciting this mantra, in the context of the other practices taught in the Sutra, can succeed in eliminating whatever internal or external obstacles may lie in the way of spiritual progress.

This all new translation of the *Surangama Sutra* was done over a period of more than six years by a committee of Buddhist academics and ordained monks lead by David Rounds, author of four books, and Dr. Ronald Epstein, a retired professor of religion and philosophy at California State University, San Francisco. Epstein, a practicing Buddhist scholar, holds a PhD in Buddhist Studies from the University of California, Berkeley and is author of the dictionary *Buddhism A to Z*.

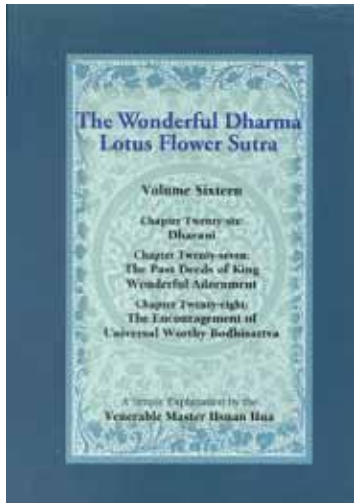

## The Wonderful Dharma Lotus Flower Sutra

first 10 volumes edited by Kuo-lin (Nancy Lethcoe), PhD

This Sutra, more commonly known in English as the *Lotus Sutra*, is one of the major Buddhist texts of East Asia. It was spoken in the last period of Shakyamuni Buddha's life and proclaims the ultimate principles of the Dharma, which unite all previous teaching into one. In this Sutra the Buddha uses parables to explain that all beings can become enlightened. He explains the purpose of his teaching by means of analogy of a father who tries to rescue his children from a burning house. He uses a rain cloud to illustrate how his teaching benefits all beings with impartiality. He also bestows predictions of Buddhahood upon his disciples.

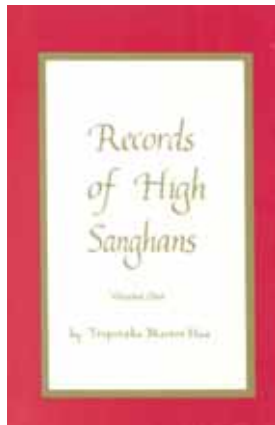
## A Pictorial Biography of the Venerable Master Hsu Yun

During his almost 120 year life span (1840-1959), Master Hsu Yun (Empty Cloud), saw the end of imperial China, the short lived rise of the democratic republic, two world wars and the eventual rule of the Chinese Communist Party.

Master Hsu Yun, a true sage of the 19th and early 20th centuries, valiantly and almost single handedly kept orthodox Buddhism alive for the Asian people. He founded Jen Ru Monastery in Jiang Xi and restored Nan Hua Monastery in Canton, the bodhimanda of the Sixth Patriarch Hui Neng. He can be considered one of the last Buddhist patriarchs of China. His main disciples, took the mind-to-mind seal, passed down from patriarch to patriarch from the original master Shakyamuni Buddha, across the Pacific Ocean to America.

Volume 1 covers the Master's birth and education through his enlightenment. Volume 2 covers the Master's propagation of Buddhism throughout Asia.

## Records of High Sanghans

Biographies of eminent Buddhist Masters who brought orthodox Buddhism from India to China between the first and fifth century C.E.

Kashyapa Matanga and Gobharana translated the *Sutra in 42 Sections*, the first Buddhist Sutra translated from Sanskrit into Chinese at the White Horse Temple near Luo Yang in 69 C.E.

Kumarajiva (344-413) headed the translation center in the Chinese capital of Chang An with over 800 monks and lay scholars. He translated the *Lotus Sutra* into Chinese.

Fa Hsien in the 5th century, was one of the first Chinese monks to make the difficult journey from China to India. He translated the Sanga Vinaya and the Nirvana Sutra into Chinese.

Other masters include An Shih Kao, Dharmaraksha and Gunabhadra.



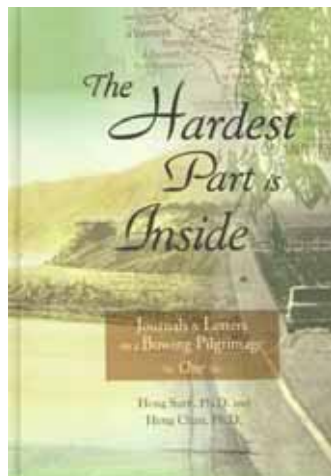
